TEXTURAL TRENDS

THINK KITCHEN DESIGN is all about what you see? Think again.

The trend of using textured and tactile materials in our kitchens, on surfaces, benchtops, doors and splashbacks emerged last year and it's here to stay in 2015:

Benchtops – Natural marble and granite in honed finishes, as well as engineered stones that replicate raw finishes.

Doors and drawers – Wood grain, in its natural form, as well as using solid surfaces such as Staron.

Splashbacks, taps and sinks – Warmer metals, like gold, copper and bronze, will have their moment to shine.

The combination of decadence and raw is really on trend as we look for ways to "get back to nature" in our homes. Mixing up textures and finishes will add a polished effect and can bring depth to a neutral colour palette. However, it's important to not overcrowd a space with strong textures, instead only choose one textured material as the hero and complement it with gloss or matt finishes through the rest of the kitchen.
